3. Students who will be hosted at UIW are required to live on\_campus.

4. Each exchange student will receive access to his/her stUdent account, Course information, housing information, etc. through UIW's CRM "BannerWeb"

5. Incoming exchange students with disabilities are asked to contact the Coordinator of Sister School Partnerships (IIersI]ing@uiwtx.edu), who will facilitate communication with Student Disability Services: http://www.uiw.edu/sds/

6. The office of the Registra rwill issueofficial transcriptsofastudent's academic record, including courses, grades, GpA, and degree upon request of the student. Transcripts can only be released directly to the student or to a person or entity designated by the student. There is a \$2.90 service fee per transcript, with a lirnit up of 5 per order, Students may request a digital coPY or paper copy mailed via post. Please note: We suggest you do not request a transcriPt until after grades are posted (please see Acadeuic\_Calendar). Be sure to check with the Business Office & the office of the Registrar to see if you have any holds. Transcripts will not be released until all holds are removed.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement:

It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 2018 will only take effect as of 1 September 2019. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

This Agreement wilt be effective when it is signed by the representatives of both institutions and witl be valid for the time period stated above, It may be subject to revision or modification from time to

time by mutual agreement including the attachment of additionat schedtiles as they are developed, In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given, This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
