RO GALATI01:

Students: The sending institution should send a nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) to the International Relations Office/Erasmus (bianca.chiosa@ugal.ro) prior to the nomination deadline. An invitation will be released upon home university request.

Students must arrive at least 3 days before the academic year/semester starts, but not during the weekends.

Students in Bachelor and Master study programs are allowed to attend courses of maximum 63 credits/academic year and 33 credits/semester.

Staff: Teaching and non-teaching staff should send (dan.scarpete@ugal.ro) their Teaching or Training Programme prior to their arrival at the University "Dunarea de Jos" of Galati. An invitation will be released upon staff request.

Disabled Students and Staff are welcome.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

Within 15 days after their arrival, they need to register within Immigration Office, providing a proof of sufficient funding and health insurance coverage. Students will be assisted to prepare their registration in order to get their residence permit.


