# ANEX AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

## Article 1

The University of Belgrade Faculty of Philology and the Faculty of Fine Arts, Atatürk University, determine and regulate with this agreement the areas and matters of mutual cooperation as well as the forms and manners of its implementation.

#### Article 2

Cooperation will be undertaken, subject to availability of funds and the approval of the University of Belgrade Faculty of Philology and Faculty of Fine Arts, Atatürk University, through such activities or programs related to:

- 1. Exchange of faculty professors and staff
- 2. Exchange of students
- 3. Joint research activities
- 4. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
- 5. Special short-term academic programs
- 6. Professional Development Programs
- 7. Other areas in which concrete mutual interest in cooperation is established or will develop.

## Article 3

Each faculty shall designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate the realization of specific activities or programs.

#### Article 4

The implementation of this agreement is dependent upon the availability of funds for joint activities. All commitments, obligations and expenditures related to projects approved under this agreement shall be administered in accordance with each institution's normal practices and policies and the specific terms and conditions of the funding agencies.

#### Article 5

Possible amendments and additions to this agreement shall be considered in writing and annexed

to this agreement.

# Article 6

The parties agree that, if by reason of strike or other labor disputes, civil disorders, severe weather, or other unavoidable cause beyond the control of the party seeking to invoke this paragraph, either party is unable to perform its obligations, such non-performance shall not be considered a breach of this agreement.

## Article 7

This agreement shall remain in force for a five (5) year period from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be extended by mutual agreement in writing for additional five (5) year period. This agreement may be terminated by either party giving six (6) months written notice to the partner institution.

## Article 8

This agreement shall go into effect when signed by the dean of both faculties.

# Article 9

This agreement has been drawn in four (4) originals, two (2) of them in Serbian, two (2) of them in English.
