Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University will provide accommodation for the athletes and coaches.

It will be highly appreciated if the Member Universities inform the Secretariat about their participation at the Sport Games, as well as submit sport disciplines which they will attend and the list of participant of the athletes and coaches for each discipline by 15 February 2017.

The Secretariat also has the honour to enclose herewith the "Regulations of the First Sport Games of the Turkic University Union" prepared by the Secretariat and Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University.

REGULATIONS OF THE "FIRST SPORT GAMES OF THE TURKIC UNIVERSITY UNION"

I. Purposes and Objectives

First Sport Games of the Turkic University Union (hereinafter referred to as "First Sport Games") has the following purposes and objectives:

- 1. Adhering to the founding documents of the Turkic Council and in accordance with the decisions taken by the Heads of States at the 3rd and 4th Summits of the Turkic Council, the purpose of the "First Sport Games" is to complement to the efforts aimed at contributing to the comprehensive cooperation among the Member States of the Cooperation Council of Turkic Speaking States (Turkic Council) through sports competitions among university student-athletes.
- 2. Strengthening and further developing friendship, harmony and cooperation among the Universities of the Turkic University Union (Union).
- 3. Establish a tradition of sport competitions within the Union to enhance fraternal relations among the students.

II. Date and Venue

- 1. The First Sport Games will be hosted by the Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University (hereinafter referred to as "Manas University") on 15-19 May 2017 in Bishkek, Kyrgyz Republic.
- 2. The sport competitions will be held at the facilities of the Manas University in Bishkek Kyrgyz Republic.
- 3. Arrival date of delegations: 13-14 May 2017. The opening of the First Sport Games: 15 May 2017. The closing of the First Sport Games: 19 May 2017. Departure date of delegations: 20 May 2017.

III. Types of the Games

- 1. Mini Football (men, participation: 7 athletes + 1 coach)
- 2. Streetball (mixed teams, participation: 4 athletes + 1 coach)
- 3. Volleyball (women, participation: 8 athletes + 1 coach)
- 4. Wrestling Freestyle (men, participation: 5 athletes + 1 coach)
- 5. Wrestling Greco-Roman (men, participation: 5 athletes + 1 coach)

IV. Participation

- 1. The athletes attending the First Sport Games must be the students (undergraduate, graduate, and PhD students) of the Member Universities of the Union.
- 2. The teams are formed by the relevant authorities of each university and duly communicated to the Manas University and the Secretariat of the Turkic Council in due course of time.

V. Management

- 1. General management and conduct of the First Sport Games is done by the Organizing Committee, comprising officials of the Manas University and Secretariat of the Turkic Council.
- 2. The Organizing Committee shall prepare the programme of the competitions as well as the activities to be organized alongside the First Sport Games.
- 3. Programme, competition results, medals etc. shall be presented on the web page of the Manas University, Secretariat of the Turkic Council and the Turkic University Union.
- 4. Manas University, in its capacity as the host of the First Sport Games shall prepare the logo of the games, which will become part of souvenirs. The flag and emblem of the Turkic Council will be used during the First Sport Games, including the opening and closing ceremonies.

VI. Responsibilities

1. The Host is responsible for the following:

- organizing the First Sport Games, including the opening and closing ceremonies and cultural events;

- meeting and accompanying the foreign delegations;

- providing transportation for the delegations from Manas Airport to Manas University and back; and all necessary transfers during the competitions;
- providing meals and accommodation for the foreign delegations;
- preparing the place for competitions;
- providing required security measures.
- 2. The Member Universities of the Union will bear the international travel expenses of their participating sports teams.
- 3. All expenses relating to the sport equipment, sport gears, uniforms etc. of the participating teams shall be borne by themselves. Host shall provide, to the best of its abilities, supplementary technical and sport equipment for trainings.
- 4. The Organizing Committee shall not be responsible for accidents (athlete's injuries during the training and competitions, etc.). Foreign delegations shall insure their athletes from accidents.

VII. Application Procedure

Applications for participation in the First Sport Games should be submitted by 15 March 2017 to the Organizing Committee. The applications must contain full names of athletes and their photos (size: 4x6) in electronic format to iro@manas.edu.kg and zuzakova@turkkon.org e-mails.

VIII. Awarding

1. The teams that win prizes in competitions at the First Sport Games shall be awarded with medals and diplomas, as well as other attributes defined by the Organizing Committee.
